4. Purpose: (continued)

educational purposes, including, but only for such purposes:

- (a) To improve the standards, practices and effectiveness of the juvenile and family courts and other courts exercising jurisdiction over families and children;
- (b) To inform or otherwise assist persons and agencies, including governmental agencies, which deal with or affect juvenile and family courts and other courts exercising jurisdiction over families and children;
- (c) To educate persons serving in or otherwise connected with juvenile and family courts and other courts exercising jurisdiction over families and children and other interested members of the public in developments and approved principles relating to such courts;
- (d) To engage in educational and research activities in furtherance of the foregoing objectives.

Solely for the above purposes, the Corporation is empowered to exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Nevada upon nonprofit corporations organized for charitable and educational purposes, including, but without limitation thereon, to receive gifts, bequests and contributions, in any form, to collect dues, and to use, apply invest and reinvest the principal and/or income therefrom or distribute the same for the above purposes.

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
NATIONAL COUNCIL OF JUVENILE AND FAMILY COURT JUDGES**

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SEVENTH: (a) No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors or officers, but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Fourth hereof. It is intended that this Corporation shall have and continue to have the status of a Corporation which is exempt from Federal income taxation under section 501(a) and the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) thereof and which is other than a private foundation as defined in section 509, and these ARTICLES shall be construed accordingly and all powers and activities hereunder shall be limited accordingly.

(b) Any reference in these Articles to a section of the Internal Revenue Code shall be interpreted to include a reference to the corresponding provisions of any applicable further United States Internal Revenue law.

EIGHTH: The Corporation shall have members. There shall be six (6) classes of membership in the Corporation: (i) Active Membership; (ii) Life Membership; (iii) Sustaining Membership; (iv) Associate Membership; (v) Honorary Membership; and (vi) Student Membership. The Bylaws of the Corporation shall establish the rights and preferences of the different classes of members and the term of membership.

NINTH: Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, distribute all of the assets of the Corporation in such manner and to such qualified organizations as the Board of Directors shall determine. An organization is a "qualified organization" only if at the time of receiving such assets it is operated exclusively for the purposes described in section 170(c)(2)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and is described in section 509(a)(1), (2) or (3) of said Code. Any of such assets not so distributed shall be distributed by the Court of appropriate jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for the aforesaid purposes of the Corporation or to such qualified organization or organizations as said Court shall determine.

TENTH: The duration of the existence of the Corporation is perpetual.

ELEVENTH: The number of Directors shall be set forth in the Bylaws. The business of the Corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors and Directors should be elected in the manner as provided in the Bylaws. There shall be at all times not fewer than one (1) individual acting as a Director hereunder. The number, titles, duties, manner of appointment and terms of office of the Officers of the Corporation shall be as set forth in the Bylaws.
